

Officers: A president-elect, vice president and secretary must be nominated. Judge Otter will become Immediate Past President and Judge Shaffer will automatically become President.

Governors: The following positions on the Board of Governors are up for election. In some instances there are incumbents; if so, the names are noted:

District I (Canada). This district has all six of the allowable positions filled. Gerald Locas, Gale Sinclair and Ken Skilnick are eligible for re-election.

District II (CT, MA, ME, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, VT). This district has only two of the possible six positions filled, and both Vincent Johnson and Damian Murray are eligible for re-election. The other four positions also may be filled.

District III (DE, DC, FL, GA, MD, PR, SC, VA, VI). This district also has only two of the six possible positions filled, and Brian Jeffcoat and Vince Lilley are eligible for re-election. The other four positions may be filled.

District IV (AL, AR, AZ, LA, MS, NM, OK, TX, Mexico). This district has all six positions filled. Yvette Alexander, Paul de Mahy, John Finley and Roxanne Song Ong are eligible for re-election.

District V (AK, CA, GU, HI, ID, Marshall Islands, MT, NMI, NV, OR, UT, WA, WY, Military Overseas). This district has five of six positions filled. Veronica Alicea-Galvan, Jennifer Klapper and Robert Torres are eligible for re-election, and the other position may be filled.

District VI (CO, KS, MI, MO, MN, ND, NE, SD, WI). This district has all six positions filled, and the Governors - Brian Campbell, Elizabeth Hines, Susan Jonas, David Parrott, Jim Vano and John Williams are all eligible for re-election.

District VII (IA, IL, IN, KY, OH, TN, WV). All six positions are filled in this district. Tom Alevizos, Paul Stanko, and Gayle Williams-Byers are eligible for re-election.

At-Large Executive Committee: One position, Veronica Alicea-Galvan incumbent. The term is for one year, and the nominee is elected by the General Assembly, not by the Board of Governors.

Court of Appeals: There is one vacancy on the 5-member Court of Appeals, and Mary Kaye Bozza's term expires this year, so there are two positions to fill.
