

Officers: A president-elect, vice president and secretary must be nominated. Judge Shaffer will become Immediate Past President and Judge Torres will automatically become President.

Governors: The following positions on the Board of Governors are up for election. In some instances there are incumbents; if so, the names are noted:

District I (Canada). This district has all six of the allowable positions filled. Catherine Carlson, Patrick Kennedy and Vaughn Myers are eligible for re-election.

District II (CT, MA, ME, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, VT). This district has only five of the possible six positions filled, but none of the five incumbents are up for election this year. Therefore, the one vacancy may be filled.

District III (DE, DC, FL, GA, MD, PR, SC, VA, VI). This district also has only one of the six possible positions filled, and Brian Jeffcoat is not up for re-election. The other five positions may be filled.

District IV (AL, AR, AZ, LA, MS, NM, OK, TX, Mexico). This district has all six positions filled. Rodney Adams and Anthony Thibodeaux are eligible for re-election.

District V (AK, CA, GU, HI, ID, Marshall Islands, MT, NMI, NV, OR, UT, WA, WY, Military Overseas). This district has four of six positions filled. Elizabeth Berns and Natalie Tyrrell are eligible for re-election, and the other two positions may be filled.

District VI (CO, KS, MI, MO, MN, ND, NE, SD, WI). There is one unexpired term to fill due to the death of John Williams. The term will expire in 2019.

District VII (IA, IL, IN, KY, OH, TN, WV). All six positions are filled in this district. Dean Colvin, Gene Lucci and Betty Moore are eligible for re-election.

At-Large Executive Committee: One position, Veronica Alicea-Galvan incumbent. The term is for one year, and the nominee is elected by the General Assembly, not by the Board of Governors.

Court of Appeals: There is one unfilled vacancy on the 5-member Court of Appeals.
