

Officers: A president-elect, vice president and secretary must be nominated. Judge Sferrazza will become Immediate Past President and Judge Alexander will automatically become President.

Governors: The following positions on the Board of Governors are up for election. If there are incumbents the names are noted:

District I (Canada). This district has all six of the allowable positions filled. Mary Curtis, Patrick Kennedy and Vaughn Myers are eligible for re-election.

District II (CT, MA, ME, NH, NJ, NY, PA, RI, VT). This district also has all six positions filled. Tracey Brandeis-Roman is eligible for re-election.

District III (DE, DC, FL, GA, MD, PR, SC, VA, VI). This district has only three of the six possible positions filled, and Berryl Anderson and Cathleen Vitale are up for re-election. The other three positions also may be filled.

District IV (AL, AR, AZ, LA, MS, NM, OK, TX, Mexico). This district has all six positions filled. Rodney Adams and Anthony Thibodeaux are eligible for re-election.

District V (AK, CA, GU, HI, ID, Marshall Islands, MT, NMI, NV, OR, UT, WA, WY, Military Overseas). This district all six positions filled. Elizabeth Berns, Scott Pearson and Natalie Tyrrell are eligible for re-election.

District VI (CO, KS, MI, MO, MN, ND, NE, SD, WI). No positions are up for election this year and all six positions are filled.

District VII (IA, IL, IN, KY, OH, TN, WV). Five of the possible six positions are filled in this district. Dean Colvin, Gene Lucci and Betty Moore are eligible for re-election. The other position may be filled.

At-Large Executive Committee: One position, Vince Johnson incumbent. The term is for one year, and the nominee is elected by the General Assembly, not by the Board of Governors.

Court of Appeals: There are no vacancies on the 5-member Court of Appeals.
